Dear Friends and Colleagues of the MGH School of Nursing,

The MGHNAA Board wishes to take this opportunity to ask for your support for the annual fund drive.

Your continued generosity allows this association to fulfill our dual mission (1) to support and foster nursing education and professional development through grants and scholarships to our membership and nursing students at the MGH Institute School of Nursing; and (2) to preserve the history of nursing education at MGH and to act as an archivist for that history.

This year, the MGHNAA awarded four \$5000 scholarships to students in the Accelerated Bachelors and Masters programs at the IHP. We have also added over \$46,000 in scholarship money to the MGHNAA Endowed Fund created for the MGH Institute School of Nursing to support the high cost of tuition.

Additionally, these funds have allowed us to preserve the history of our school and our illustrious alumnae for future generations of students and researchers of nursing history by digitizing The Quarterly Record, The Record and our yearbooks and making them available on-line at Archives.org. Your contributions have also allowed us to move the Sherwin Collection back to the MGH and to prepare a new home for the nursing archives with the MGH archives in Somerville.

Thank you from the officers and board of your Alumnae Association for your continued generosity and support of your sister alumnae and the Institute School of Nursing students and for your continued commitment to the fulfillment of our mission.

I hope to see many of you at MGH on September 23 and 24 for Continuing Education day and Homecoming.
