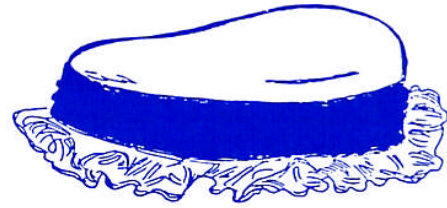

Update from Dean Clabo, MGH Institute School of Nursing

Greetings from the School of Nursing at the MGH Institute of Health Professions! It's been a very productive year in the School. Fall semester was busy with preparation for our reaccreditation visit from the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE). Each of the programs in the School of Nursing received a full ten year accreditation, the maximum term that the Commission may award. Of special note the evaluation visitors found NO compliance concerns or violations across all of our programs and they commented on several areas of excellence. Great news!

We ended the year, by graduating our largest class ever. At commencement, we awarded 159 bachelor's degrees; 111 Master's degrees and 18 Doctorates of Nursing Practice. These talented new professionals are exceptionally well prepared, and will continue to build the legacy of the MGH and the MGH IHP.
